Pinot Noir

This thin skinned black grape produces a light colored red wine with earthy aromas. (Sometimes referred to as a barnyard aroma). They range from medium to full bodied with medium tannins. This earthy quality makes them a perfect match with mushrooms, sauces, veal, pork and lamb.

Syrah

Cabernet Sauvignon

Rarely produced from 100% Cabernet, most are blended with Merlot or Cabernet Franc to soften or balance the wine. They range from medium to full bodied and mild to strong. Keep the food simple. Plain medium rare to well done steaks, veal chops and marinara sauces are great choices.

(They have done a great job!) A minimum of 3 grape varieties (Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Merlot and Petite Verdot) are used in these wines. All are full bodied and tannic and are not for the faint hearted.
